

Florida TSRP Goal:

Serve as a statewide resource that provides training, education, and technical support to prosecutors and law enforcement officers to enhance DUI enforcement and prosecution.

TSRP Program Is Grant Funded





- <u>Training</u> The Florida TSRP Program Conducts the following seminars annually:
 - Basic DUI Trial Advocacy (5 days)
 - Advanced DUI Trial Advocacy (2 days)
 - Prosecuting the Drugged Driver (2 days)
 - DUI/Vehicular Manslaughter (2 days)
 - SAO In-House Training
 - Basic DUI Case Law (4-hours)
 - Implied Consent Issues (2-hours)



- <u>LEO Specific Training</u> The Florida TSRP Program Conducts the following LEO Specific Training:
 - Basic DUI Trial Preparation (1 day)
 - Read-Off Training Available in-house upon request
 - DUI Basics 1-hr
 - Legal Background & Basics for SFSTs 2-hr
 - Implied Consent: Breath, Urine & Blood 2-hr



- <u>Technical Assistance</u> The Florida TSRP Program will provide technical assistance, upon request for numerous DUI and Traffic Safety issues, including:
 - Initial Case Analysis & Assistance
 - Legal Research Assistance
 - Policy Review and Revision
