- Florida's high rate of refusals
- Expected increase in drug-related impairment, especially marijuana and prescription drugs
- Need for more DREs/more DRE Training
- Establishments overserving alcohol

FIDC Member Survey

What specific impaired driving <u>programs and initiatives</u> do you believe the FIDC and its partners should focus on over the next 2-3 years?

- More education and training (DRE, SFST, Judicial)
- Education programs on the dangers of substance abuse
 - Outreach training on the effects of driving drug impaired

Excluding policy and legislative actions, what <u>specific actions</u> do you believe the FIDC should focus on over the next 2-3 years?


Impact of Medical Marijuana




- Provide real impairment scenarios/situations to high schools and colleges
